

## **PEER-REVIEW POLICY**

**Peer-review is the system mainly used to evaluate the quality of submitted manuscript before the decision for publishing is reached. The reviewers for the relevant area of stomatology assess submitted manuscripts for originality, validity and significance to help whether the manuscript should be published in Acta Stomatologica Naissi.**

**Journal of Acta Stomatologica Naissi is adopted policy that all manuscripts are screening for general suitability, and at least two experts in the field for content of submitted manuscript, are asked to evaluate whether the manuscript is scientifically sound and important and whether the manuscript should be accepted, rejected or revised.**

**The peer review process, is single-blind process, and is based on the traditional model of peer review that many reviewers are comfortable with, and it enables to reviewers to be a dispassionate for critique of a manuscript, because the names and affiliations of the authors are hidden from the reviewers.**

**All submitted manuscripts are handled by the Editor and it's associates, and after an initial analysis of manuscript , it is sent to at least two experts for the field corresponding to the submitted manuscript; the reviewers are asked to evaluate whether the manuscript is scientifically important and coherent and whether the manuscript should be accepted, rejected or revised. Final decisions are made by the Editor-in-Chief based on the recommendations of reviewer reports, and where necessary, Editors-in-Chief will consult with members of the Editorial Board for final decision.**
